ATHLETICS CARNIVAL MONDAY 3rd AUGUST - MINGARA ATHLETICS CENTRE

Dear Parents/Caregivers.

Brisbania Public School Athletics Carnival has been organised for the MONDAY 3rd AUGUST, 2015. The carnival is being held at MINGARA REGIONAL ATHLETICS CENTRE, Mingara Drive, Berkeley Vale. Students will be involved in a range of athletics events including shot put, discus, running, long jump, high jump and mini games.

All children in Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 (along with Year 2 students that are turning 8 this year and have elected to compete in the full carnival) will be leaving school at 9:00am and returning in time for the afternoon buses. The carnival will begin at approx 9.30am.

The remaining students in Years Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 will travel to Mingara a little later so that they are not at the carnival for the full day. This group will leave school at 10:45am.

As this is a whole school carnival, there will be no supervision for children who come to school late or not intending to go to the carnival. There will be no canteen at school.

All parents are invited to attend, however an entry fee will apply into the Regional Athletics Centre. Children will need to wear their sports uniform, with a T-Shirt of the house colour they are in.

Children will need to wear a hat and sunscreen, bring a tracksuit/jumper, raincoat/jacket (clearly labelled), recess, lunch and adequate drinks. We can't always guarantee the weather around our carnival time. It is always a good idea for the children to pack something waterproof to sit on.

All K - Year 2 children will wear their house and name tags that will be provided by their class teacher. K - Year 2 participate in athletic skills and mini games throughout the day including their 50m age races.

A canteen will be run by Mingara Recreational Club on the day. The canteen will have available various foods such as pies, sausage rolls, cans of soft drink, bottled water, juice, tea and coffee to purchase.

All children will travel by bus to the venue as per the times outlined above. Children need to be at school by 8.50am for roll marking. Buses will return to school by 2.30pm. The cost of bus travel and entry will be \$8.00 per child. Please return the money and complete the permission details before WEDNESDAY 29th JULY 2015.

If you are attending the carnival and wish your child to go home with you at the end of the day, please ensure you see the relevant class teacher to have your child's name marked off the roll.
