## Observatory Hill Environmental Education Centre

Dear Parents/Student and Carers,

This is your chance to do something positive for the planet by preparing an ECO friendly lunch for the excursion.

We are seeking your co-operation in supporting the concepts of recycling, reusing and reducing by bringing an ECO friendly lunch on your excursion.

An ECO friendly lunch is one that has only recyclable or reusable containers for packaging and reduces the amount of rubbish.

An example of an Eco friendly lunch might be:-

- Sandwiches in greaseproof paper biodegradable
- Drink in a reusable or recyclable container a water bottle is best
- Fresh fruit peeling can be composted back at school or home
- Play lunch is a paper bag (fruit and biscuits)

Containers that are environmentally friendly but should not be brought on the excursion are glass bottles and cans as they cannot be resealed.

To reduce the amount of rubbish containers that should not be brought:-

- Pre-packed portion controlled packets eg. Chips or biscuits and cheese combination packet
- Lollies in wrappers
- Drinks in throw away cartons with straws

As a general rule, don't bring anything that can't be taken home and reused or recycled.
