Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Welcome to Stage 3 at Brisbania Public School in 2017. The students have settled in well to the rigour and routines of Stage 3 and are looking forward to a positive year ahead. The Stage 3 staff are excited to deliver high quality education that promotes collaboration and an inquiry approach to learning that embeds the use of technology and 21st Century learning.

The team of teachers on Stage 3 this year are Mr Michael Ingram (5M), Mr Greg Anderson (5A), Mrs Shelley Wilding (6W), Mrs Sharon Howe (6H) and Mr Clint Lowe (5/6L). Outlined below is an overview of the content covered across all Key Learning Areas throughout the year. There is also some additional information regarding student requirements and other relevant information.

English

Each class will participate in guided lessons on reading and writing based on the specific needs of the students within each class. Speaking and listening activities, including debating, will also be embedded across all subjects. Grammar and spelling will be both taught within units of work as well as explicit teaching lessons. In Semester 1, Year 6 students will undertake a unit of work developed by the Stage 3 teachers from the Erina Learning Community (ELC). Samples from this unit will also form a part of the Year 7 A-stream class application. More information regarding this process will be communicated later on this year.

Mathematics

All Stage 3 students will be placed in ability-based groups in Week 4, Term 1. This will assist all students in accessing the curriculum at their own level of ability. Groups will be fluid with changes made throughout the year based on student needs and at the discretion of teachers.

Science and Technology (Inquiry-based units of work)

Two units will be studied this year in an inquiry-based learning environment. Inquiry-based pedagogy is essential to develop higher-order thinking, problem solving and critical thinking. The ultimate goal is to allow students to be active, digital citizens in a world unlike the world we know today. Units covered will be *Micro-organisms* and *Earthquake Explorers*.

History (Inquiry-based unit of work)

In accordance with the History syllabus and Australian Curriculum, students will study one history unit per grade, with units complementing excursions throughout the year.

Geography (Inquiry-based unit of work)

This year, students will be studying the unit, Factors that Shape Places.
