

# MUSICAL DRESS REHEARSALS AND PERFORMANCE PERMISSION NOTE

Venue: Erina High School Cost: \$5 per student

Dates and Times: Thursday, 31 August - 9.15am – 2.00pm Thursday, 7 September - 9.30am – 1.00pm and 6.00pm – 8.30pm

## Purpose and activities:

SCHOOL MUSICAL – All students will be involved in singing, dancing, performing and/or acting on stage at Erina High School. Whilst waiting to perform, students will play games, sporting activities, watch DVD's, draw or read.

Students will travel by **bus** to and from Brisbania PS for the rehearsal (31.08.17) and Matinee (07.09.17).

#### Thursday, 31 August for Dress Rehearsal of the Musical

- Students will travel by bus to Erina High School (EHS). Kindergarten to Years 6 will leave at <u>9.15am</u> and return at approximately 2.00pm.
- They will be in the school's multi-purpose building (hall) watching other performances or supervised outside the hall in preparation for their performance.
- Students will return to school in time to catch buses home as normal.
- They will need to bring their costume etc if not already at school
- They will need to bring their recess, lunch and drinks as normal. (No canteen is available at Erina HS)
- They will take their school bags with them to EHS.
- Students may bring something quiet to do when waiting a book to read, colouring in etc
- Photos will also be taken
- The Brisbania Canteen will be closed on this day.

#### Thursday, 7 September for the Matinee performance.

- Students will come to school as normal (even if parents are attending the matinee).
- Students will travel by bus to the matinee. All students to leave Brisbania by bus at <u>9.30am</u> and return at approximately 1pm.
- Students will be supervised outside the hall, in a holding area waiting to perform, in the hall performing, and on stage.
- Students will return to school in time to catch buses home as normal.
- They will need to bring their costume etc. if not already at school
- They will need to bring their recess, lunch and drinks as normal. (No canteen is available at Erina HS)
- They will take their school bags with them to EHS.
- Students may bring something quiet to do when waiting a book to read, colouring in etc.
- The Brisbania Canteen will be closed on this day.

## Thursday, 7 September for the Evening performance

- Students will need to make their own way to Erina High School. If you are unable to transport your child please
  arrange a lift with a friend's family or contact your child's teacher.
- Students will need to arrive by 5.45pm and meet their teacher in the bus COLA.
- Students may bring something quiet to do when waiting a book to read, colouring in etc.
- Students may bring a water bottle and/or healthy snack.
- Students will be outside the hall, in holding rooms waiting to perform, in the hall performing and on stage.
- Students need to remain until the end of the performance. All students are involved in the finale.
- Parents are asked to remain in the hall whilst students leave to their designated "pick up" areas. Details of the "pick up" arrangements will be advised closer to the performance.
- Musical will be filmed for DVD.

A risk assessment has been undertaken and strategies put in place to ensure the safety of students and the audience. These include risks involving performing on an elevated stage, wearing costumes, wearing make-up, standing on steps and performance boxes, moving around darkened areas whilst getting on and off stage, singing and dancing on stage, using microphones, using props, using instruments and supervision of students.

During waiting times at rehearsals and performances, students may be involved in games, sports activities, watching DVDs or other activities to keep them occupied.

### **PARTICIPATION**

It is the staff's expectation that **all students** participate in the rehearsal and matinee/night performances. These activities have been approved as part of the Creative Arts program. Students need to attend school on these days.

Participation in the musical develops performance skills (dance moves, keeping in time, working in unison etc.) It also develops the five keys to success: - Persistence, Getting Along, Confidence, Resilience, Organisation.

Whilst we understand that some students may have other commitments on the Thursday night, we ask that all parents encourage their child to be part of the performance. This is a great opportunity to perform to a live audience.
