PAYMENTS

If you are sending in notes or money, please include your child's name and class on the envelope and note, as this makes it much easier for our busy School Administrative Officers.

USING YOUR BACK TO SCHOOL VOUCHERS

We have now received instructions on how Brisbania PS can register as a program provider so you can use your *Back to school* vouchers for Learning Pack payments or excursions.

The entire \$50 voucher must be used, in one transaction, and no change or refunds can be given. Multiple vouchers can be used at once on the same purchase. Vouchers can only be used once. They can not be used as credit towards future expenses.

Please be patient as we navigate the school requirements and procedures to redeem your vouchers, they are valid until 30 June 2023.

Please note that the P&C Uniform Shop has not yet been able to set up their account.

The vouchers can not be used for our voluntary fees.

LEARNING PACKS

In 2023, our Learning Packs are \$100 per student. Our learning packs include but are not limited to subscription costs for students, subscription costs for teachers to access resources for students' learning, books, whiteboards, Handwriting textbook, stationary supplies, art and craft supplies and technology supplies including STEM resources.

VOLUNTARY FEES

In addition to our Learning Packs, Brisbania PS has voluntary fees, that have not increased for the past 5 years. The fees are:- \$50 for one child, \$70 for two children and \$80 for 3 or more children.

BODY AND MIND WELLBEING SESSIONS– FRIDAYS

Our popular wellbeing sessions began on Friday and continue for the term. Please pay the \$36 fee ASAP. The sessions assist all our students to increase their awareness of their emotional responses to everyday problems, the impact emotions have on their body and mind and to practise these tools in a safe and calm environment.

SWIMMING CARNIVAL

Our annual swimming carnival will be held at the Peninsula Leisure Centre at Woy Woy on Friday 17 February for Years 3 to 6 and students turning 8 who are competent swimmers and can swim a qualifying time of boys– 1 min 4 seconds and girls 1min 10 sec for 50m freestyle. Travel is to and from the pool by bus. The cost of the bus and entry to pool is \$12 per child.

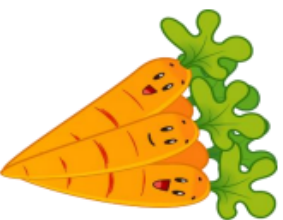
