

Our Term One P&C organised disco will be held on Wednesday 5 April, food opens at 4pm.



Some of our Years 4-6 Aboriginal students were invited to attend a Cultural dig down at the Illoura Dog Reserve, Davistown on Wednesday last week.

Ausgrid in partnership with Tracey, Kyle and Uncle Phil who are the Cultural Heritage Officers performed a dig to seek if there were any middens left from Aboriginal people along the Coast.

Tracey talked about the artefacts they collected over the years of participating in these significant cultural digs.

She also showed us the types of ancient rocks that she has come across over the years of doing these digs.

We learnt so much about the importance of preserving Aboriginal middens and continuing to build on our cultural knowledge.

Thank you to Liam Baker for including us in this, learning about our local Aboriginal history, so we can pass onto the younger generations.

- *A 5 step evidence-based psychological first aid framework (TAR3) for you to follow when responding 'in the moment' to episodes of distress and behavioural challenges. For example, TAR3 is the equivalent of the DR ABC process for responding to first aid.
- *Guidance on simple ways you can help young people build coping, resilience and positive help seeking behaviour and the vital role you play in promoting this.
- *Context on why child & adolescent mental health occurs and what you can do to improve mental health outcomes for the young people you support.
- *Coaching in the use of scripts and engagements strategies to adopt when responding to distress using the TAR3 Psychological First Aid Method.
