Without the P&C, our school would not have a canteen or uniform shop. We are grateful to the volunteers who run the uniform shop and to the P&C Executive. These parents work tirelessly behind the scenes to stocktake, order and organise uniform orders, pay our canteen supervisors, pay invoices and organise events.

The P&C Executive also organise fundraising events throughout the year such as raffles, cake stalls and Mothers and Fathers Day stalls. Money raised pays for the canteen, uniform shop stock and donations to the school.

EHS transition

This week, EHS begin this year's transition program. EHS is our local high school with a wonderful transition program to allow students to experience high school prior to starting. Past Brisbania PS students and one of the Deputy Principals visit Year 6 to answer questions and talk about high school.

On 6 March, there is an Open Night for Year 5 and 6 parents and students from 5:30pm. Other opportunities for our students include: NAIDOC DAY for our Stage 3 Aboriginal students who can take along a buddy; Science week assembly for K-6 with Erina HS students and Science staff enthralling us with experiments.; ex students assisting us at carnivals; Gala day opportunities for Year 5 and 6; Orientation Day for Year 6 to 7 on 3 December and HPGE Day for Stage 3 students to work with EHS staff and students. Students requiring extra transition sessions are also accommodated.

EMERGENCY PLANNING AND ARRANGEMENTS DURING THE BUSHFIRE SEASON

Brisbania Public School is in a bushfire prone area and is identified as Category 2 on the NSW Department of Education's bushfire risk register.

During the school term, when the NSW Rural Fire Service declares a Catastrophic Fire Danger Rating for the Central Coast, the NSW Department of Education's policy requires the school to temporarily cease operations for the following day. This means the school will be non-operational on these days. The school will inform the school community after 4 pm if there is a change to the operational status of the school for the following day.

In addition, schools may be made non-operational due to changing higher risk conditions and advice from Emergency Services and the State Emergency Operations Centre.

KINDNESS CURRICULUM

This year, Brisbania PS is using the Kindness Curriculum to support our Wellbeing focus.



STEWART HOUSE DONATIONS

In the spirit of kindness, if you could donate \$2 or more to Stewart House, you can go in a draw to win a \$4 000 gift voucher.

Please return envelopes by 25 March, to the office. We will then send envelopes to Stewart House to go in the draw.

Every year, 1,600 public school children attend Stewart House's safe haven next to Curl Curl beach at no cost to their parents or carers. During a 12-day stay, they are provided with dental, optical, hearing and medical screening and treatment.

Children participate in educational programs and excursions designed to develop their social and emotional skills, build self-esteem and improve their overall wellbeing.

This experience provides children with a much-needed break from their current circumstances. Students attending Stewart House are inspired to see beyond the present and to have real hope and positive aspirations for their future.

Children in the care of Stewart House attend a specific purpose school onsite for 10 days of their 12-day stay. The NSW Department of Education provides infrastructure and staffing support for this school. All other costs associated with the children's stay are met from charitable donations. Each year, approximately 80 students from the Central Coast attend Stewart House.

MOVING INTO YEAR 7 IN A NSW GOVERNMENT SCHOOL IN 2025 (FOR YEAR 6 PARENTS)

The Year 6 Orientation Day will be on Tuesday 3 December.

Parents of Year 6 students are asked to complete the online Expression of Interest form from 6 March 2024.

To enrol your child in Year 7 for 2025, you will need to complete an Expression of Interest for Year 6 to Year 7 transition. The Expression of Interest (EOI) lets you indicate which school(s) you would like your child to attend in Year 7.

The EOI process is available online. After you submit an EOI and it has been assessed, your child will be offered a place at a high school. EOI forms will be available on our website under the enrolment heading from 6 March 2024.


If your child will not be attending a NSW Government high school next year, please let us know by completing a Placement Not Required form.

If you are unsure whether they will be attending a NSW Government school (you've applied for a private school, or you are moving interstate), we ask that you still complete an EOI and follow up with your school once a decision has been made.

The online process from **6 March 2024** will guide you through your options and collect the information required to make the process as smooth as possible. The last day to submit online EOIs is Wednesday 10 April. Paper copies need to be returned by 28 March 2024.

For parents/carers who are not able to complete an application online, a paper EOI form can be collected from the school office.


